DFC to Start Regional Fellowships



"I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received . . . Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:1 and 2). These verses and those that follow (3–7 and 11–13) speak of God's intentions for those he has gifted as leaders. He intends them to equip his people for service to build up his church. PRMI's short-term mission trips are strategic opportunities to advance the Kingdom of God. Canadians have gone on missions jointly with PRMI, but DFC could not issue charitable tax receipts to donors who provided financial support for Canadians going on such trips. That changed when DFC recently created an Agency Agreement with PRMI that allows DFC to issue such tax receipts.

Our purpose in doing missions is to:

- Equip church leaders around the world to do ministry in the power of the Holy Spirit and to teach others to do the same.
- Do ministry so mission team members and their supporters/churches grow in understanding the Great Commission and how to carry it out effectively, and into a deeper relationship with Christ.

- Inspire team members and their supporters to creatively renew home congregations.
- Build financial, spiritual, and prayer support for PRMI administrative services and full-time workers in foreign countries.
- Raise new teams for more countries.

In 2012, PRMI hopes to conduct missions in Nicaragua, Indonesia, Japan, Haiti, Congo, Uganda, Korea, and South Sudan. If you are interested in a future mission project, please contact the DFC office.
