Dunamis Video Course Testimonies



Gateways to Empowered Ministry became available as a DVD courses in 2002. In the Spirit's Power, and the Power of Prayer have become available on DVD since then. The fourth DVD, Evangelism, is expected to be made in 2009. These DVDs with their manuals present Reformed based, Biblical teaching on the Holy Spirit to the Glory of God. The DVD courses, as developed by Brad Long of Presbyterian Reformed Ministries International are inviting and educational, making it possible for many churches to cooperate in the power of the Holy Spirit. The DVD courses have reached hundreds of churches, but there are thousands more to go!

Obedience to the Still Small Voice



After having attended a Dunamis Conference on The Power of Prayer, I was excited to put listening prayer into practice. I spent several weeks tuning my ear to the still small voice that would be something other than myself. One particular evening I was praying for my neighbour as I prepared to feed my three-month-old screaming twins. A clear thought suddenly interjected my thoughts: 'go right now and tell your neighbour you are praying for her.' I hesitated in accepting that this might be the Holy Spirit's prompting. It made no sense. My relationship with my neighbour was minimal and to leave right now would upset the hungry twins. However, the thought persisted and was distinctly not my own. I decided to take the risk. I prayed first, asking God to bring peace over the twins as I laid them down. They quietly nestled together in peaceful silence. There was no choice now but to knock on the neighbouring door.

My neighbour was clearly upset when she answered and quickly stated she had no time to talk. Before she retreated, I took hold of her hand and shared God's command to me. "God told me to come over and let you know that I am praying for you." She closed the door.

The twins began to cry the moment I stepped back into the safety of my own home. I felt like a fool. I should not have taken the risk. The small friendship that had been sparked was likely to be jeopardized. I had a restless night, but continued to pray for her. Early the next morning the neighbour knocked on my door, "Why did you do that last night?" she asked. I explained the small voice. Proceeding, she described the terrible argument she had with her spouse last night that threatened their marriage. She explained that seconds before I knocked on the door she looked up at heaven and called out to God. She demanded that if he really cared for her he would do something.

For the rest of that morning she heard the gospel of God's hope for her life. Her marriage was saved. Obeying the still small voice to take a risk went well beyond what I thought possible. To know and understand that God needs the participation of his saints to reach others is a great blessing.

A Different Sort of March Break... March 25-29... Come to the Dunamis Project!



Dunamis projects are no ordinary Christian conferences. Yes, there's wonderful worship; yes, there's solid Biblical teaching from a Reformed theological perspective. But there's also "lab time" and "debriefing" – opportunities to actually put into practice the principles for empowered ministry and then to talk through the experience - to question and wrestle with the ideas and how God uses ordinary folks to do some wonderful work.

Years ago we attended Dunamis Projects held in Guelph, and God invited us through those experiences into a whole new dimension of ministry to advance his Kingdom. Our adventure of serving God has never been the same. You may have been to an Ignite, or a Dunamis Conference – of which there have been a number in Ontario in the past 5 years. Those in many ways are Dunamis-"lite" by the sheer fact that the Dunamis teachings and ministry are squeezed into 1-1½ days.

In contrast, each of the six different **Dunamis Projects** is a four-day event (Wed. evening – Sunday noon) to equip spiritual leaders for Holy Spirit empowered ministry. A series of six Dunamis Projects in a given location make up a **Dunamis Track**.

We're excited that, for the first time since the mid-90's, a full Dunamis track is starting in southern Ontario. Project #1: Gateways to Empowered Ministry, about the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit, is being offered in March in Ancaster at Canterbury Hills Retreat Centre. Dr. Brad Long, Executive Director of PRMI, and Rev. Cindy Strickler, Director of the Dunamis Fellowship, are to be the teachers at this event.

If you or other leaders in your Christian community recognize your need for the Holy Spirit's power to accomplish the impossible (in our own strength) task of fulfilling the Great Commission – then clear your calendar and come join us!


